Meeting Minutes

1. Announcements

- a. Greg Miraglia announced that the Administration of Justice Program was not included in the suspension of the Police Academy, and is therefore still an active program at NVC.
 - i. Greg also answered questions concerning the recent suspension of the Police Academy Program and its effect on other programs/students/staff.
- b. Christine Pruitt would like NVCFA to file a FOIA Request for all documents concerning the NVC Housing Project.
- c. Lisa Yanover briefly discussed changes to Public Comment process at BoT Meetings.
 - i. Public comment can happen at the beginning or prior to any Agenda item.
- d. Dr. Eileene Tejada shared conversations she's had with other Senate Presidents concerning the relationship between Academic Senate RT and the 50% Law. They have indicated their colleges house Senate RT under instruction.

2. No April Meeting

- a. Unless something necessitates a general meeting, such as a vote or other vital information. A special meeting will be called in the circumstance that it is necessary.

4. Part-Time Issues

- a. Official message from the District: “No Faculty Layoffs”
- b. However, 25 Part-Time Faculty have lost their jobs here.
- c. Pres. Iwamoto will speak about this at BoT Meeting tonight.

5. NVCFA Elections

- a. Exec. Board needs Treasurer and Part-Time Representative due to current Board Members leaving, but NVCFA encourages nominations to all positions (Pres., VP, Secretary, Treasurer, Part-Time Rep.)
- b. Candidates declare by April 8th
- c. Elections open April 18-25
- d. New Exec. Board will be declared April 26th

6. Negotiations Update (Chief Neg. Quinlan)

- a. Calendar
 - i. Membership vote indicated desire for Option 3 ([Fall](#)) ([Spring](#))
 - 1. With Late start in Both Fall and Spring
 - ii. District is taking Option 3 back to their side to look over.
 - 1. No Push back so far.
- b. Program Coordinators
 - i. Chief Neg. Quinlan presented District Reassign Proposal Table
 - ii. Also presented the NVCFA Counter, that included a data adjustment according to FTEF Calculation
 - iii. Latest District Counter Proposal
 - 1. 30% Maximum RT for any PC
 - 2. 20% RT or more to be Faculty choice between RT and Stipend
 - 3. Less than 20% would be stipend, except in
 - a. Cumulative effect to 20%
 - 4. Other CTE duties will be negotiated on the side separate from normal duties
 - 5. Working with Academic Senate RT to have it *incorporated into the contract*
 - a. There was a question about whether this will include Assessment Coordinator, Prof. Dev. Coordinator, and DE Coordinator. Pres. Iwamoto will look into this.
 - 6. Academic Senate RT and Program Coordinators RT are separate conversations
 - 7. RT Questions
 - a. There was a question about how much NVC was saving with RT changes
 - i. ~180%

7. Q&A

- a. What if someone has time left on PC Contracts?
 - i. There is no answer either way for this question, but District does not seem inclined to honor the current contract of any PC if the compensation changes in negotiations.

1. In the past, however, District has acquiesced to signed contract policy.
